Yerbol A. Omarov, Adil U. Inkarbekov. The victim's rights in the use of coercive measures during pre-trial investigation in the Republic of Kazakhstan. Kazakhstan has adopted a policy of procedural economy, which is expressed in the acceleration of the passage of criminal cases at all stages of the criminal process. The introduction of many new procedural institutions and forms of pre-trial in-vestigation, the updating of criminal procedure legislation actualizes the issue of investigating the proce-dural status of the victim. The modern domestic criminal process should provide a balance between nu-merous novelties and procedural rules designed to ensure compliance with the principle of competition and equality of the parties to the prosecution and defense. In accordance with this principle, "the parties involved in criminal proceedings are equal, that is, they are given equal opportunities to defend their posi-tion in accordance with the Constitution of the Republic of Kazakhstan and the CPC.

The authors have studied international documents regarding the regulation of the rights of victims in criminal proceedings. The victim is one of the Central figures in the criminal process, especially if it is a crime against the person, and must have broad rights to protect their interests. In this regard, the issue of choosing a preventive measure against a suspect (accused), taking into account the opinion of the victim, is of particular importance. The authors studied the opinions of scientists and practitioners on the issue under consideration, as well as the provisions of criminal procedure legislation regulating the rights and obligations of the victim, the ratio of General and special norms.

As a result, the authors concluded that it is necessary to grant the victim the right to Express his opinion on the use or non-use of coercive measures against the suspect. In the course of studying this issue, the authors applied methods of comparative analysis, deduction, forecasting, and others. On the basis of the research, appropriate recommendations were developed to improve the legal regulation of the rights of the victim in criminal proceedings of the Republic of Kazakhstan.
